This need has led to research in areas such as decentralized networking, queuing theory, and packet switching. As a result of these events, the emergence of the ARPANET in the United States spurred the further development of events.

The first network system based on the TCP/IP protocol was created in 1984 at the US National Academy of Sciences, which later became the NSFNet project. In 1995, commercial versions of the Internet began to emerge. 1991 CERN announced the World Wide Web project. This happened 2 years after Tim Berners-Lee's creation of HTML, HTTPs and the first web pages at CERN. 1993 Version 1.0 of the first Internet browser, Mosaic, was released, and in 1994, it was released to the Internet. public interest began to arise. Since 1996, the word Internet has been widely used, but it mainly refers to the World Wide Web. At the same time, the Internet spread very quickly in 10 years, its open architecture, non-proprietary nature, lack of central control caused it to develop organically. The Internet is now recognized as one of mankind's greatest technological achievements¹. Now, if we pay attention to the



word "information" related to the topic of the Internet, "information" refers to all the information that a person receives through his senses. Information is derived from the Latin word information, which means explanation, statement of something, or information about something or an event. With the help of human sense organs, various devices in technology, etc recorded external world evidence is called data.
