Abstract

This article describes the use of the plural word to reinforce the level of meaning of the word to which it is connected, by relating it mainly to adjectives and adverbs.

The word plural is regarded as a word of quantity in all textbooks and manuals on Uzbek linguistics. At the same time it also has the feature of gaining rank by linking to words denoting a character. This is also already recorded in linguistics. And that's basically what we're talking about.

The plural primarily serves to increase the level of meaning of the word to which it is connected, depending on the adjectives and adverbs.

For example, now that I know I'm a lot of an immoral guy, the Roadster juvonmarg (Oybek). It is a very rewarding job to receive blessings on such fasting days

(G. Ghulam).

In these examples, the plural has reinforced the level of meaning of the immoral and noble words. This situation can be seen even more closely in the connection of many words to original adjectives.

For example, do a lot of good intentions, guilt, " Sultanmurod (Oybek) said. As long as you have a comrade who says donation, many stupid people seem (a. Qahhor). These roads are many ancient roads (G. Ghulam).

It also reinforces the meaning when the plural is attached to a word of the order Ravish.

For example, The Guest said a lot correctly (Oybek). There will be a lot of bad, if it is true, because at the time of the reform it indicates the Desolation of the villages. (A. Qahhor).

In this place, the concept of quantity in the meaning of the word plural is not understood in any way, but it has strengthened the level of meaning of the word to which it is connected. This meaning intensification is more weakly expressed than the word "Very", which means another level. In addition to adjectives and inflection derivatives, the plural also increases the level of meaning by binding to verbs that represent passive action-state.

For example: I couldn't say I missed you a lot,

It was not possible, that is why quizmat (R. Grandfather).



Saidius was very interested in knowing the tension between the donation and Salimjan (a. Autonomous). In such cases, many words, although weak, are coming in the function of the very word, strengthening the level of meaning of the verbs to miss, to be interested. Thus, the plural is attached to verbs that represent adjectives, inflections, and passive action - States, reinforcing and expressing the meaning level of the word.
