

## THE IMPORTANCE OF PARTNERSHIPS IN CAREER CHOICE

In the textbooks and manuals of NAMuslimov, OAKuysinov and BIMuronov on choosing a profession, the teacher thinks about the responsibility of teachers and parents to choose the way of life of a teenager. In order to give the right advice in this regard, teachers need to know who children and students want to be and what they hope to do, how much effort he or she is putting into it, and how far his or her goals can be achieved.



The first of the existing problems in this area is that many secondary schools are staffed with staff who do not fit into their areas of education. In such cases, the work of self-incorrectly framed personnel is carried out only superficially.

Second, the family with some secondary schools is in a weakness of cooperation between the community. Today's observations show that it is difficult for a student to find his or her place in life as a result of an educator or teacher ignoring the negative changes in children's education and upbringing and not disclosing them until the end. In our opinion, these neglects are left without proper treatment in the family and in the community.

Third, these partnerships should not be viewed as merely a formality, but as a process that works honestly in practice, guaranteeing positive results.

Fourth, secondary schools do not have separate staff and staff, such as "Educational Institution for Cooperation" or "Deputy Director for Cooperation" and are not appointed on the basis of new regulations. Therefore, the lack of communication with other educational institutions and educational institutions (formal and informal), perhaps, general secondary schools, special boarding schools, children's centers of harmoniously developed generation, music and art schools, non-cooperation with sports schools, production private and public enterprises, associations, research institutes, centers, including foreign educational organizations and educational institutions, etc.

Fifth, there should be no compulsory involvement in roadside activities that are not provided for in the secondary school plan and are not planned from the beginning of the school year. Because neither the educator, nor the staff of educational institutions and educational institutions are ready for such a "sudden" event, as a result of which this "event" is held only in the name of pedagogical, didactic, methodological efficiency is very low.

Based on the above, in accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 5, 2018 "On additional measures to improve the management system of public education", in order to strengthen corporate governance and public control in secondary schools Supervisory boards have been set up, consisting of mothers, alumni, sponsors and other community members. Parents who are not indifferent to the fate of their children should get acquainted with the activities of this council and express their views.

Principles of effective cooperation with families and secondary schools:

- 1. All families and schools want only the best for their children.
- 2. All children have the opportunity to reach their full potential.
- 3. Families are the first and permanent guardians of their children.
- 4. Effective educational organizations and educational institutions provide a nurturing and supportive learning environment.
- 5. Families and educational institutions, educational institutions value quality teaching and respect teachers.
- 6. Families and educational institutions, educational institutions value the diversity of children and use it as a resource.



- 7. Cooperation between family and educational organizations, educational institutions should be based on mutual responsibility, respect and trust.
- 8. Leadership is critical to establishing, maintaining, and renewing partnerships.
- 9. Cooperation between family and educational organizations, educational institutions improve the motivation and knowledge of students.
